

WEEE: Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment

Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) contains materials, components and substances that can be hazardous to human health and the environment. Waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) must be disposed of properly.

Products labelled with a crossed-out rubbish bin are electrical and electronic equipment. The crossed-out rubbish bin symbolises that waste electrical and electronic equipment may not be disposed of together with unsorted household waste, but must be collected separately.

According to WEEE 2002/96/EC, each Member State of the EU is under an obligation to set up schemes for processing WEEE.

In Denmark, small amounts of waste, whose type and volume equals that of private households, may be disposed of at a municipal recycling station.
